Alternatively, and perhaps preferably, does DRUPAL support an access control list? John will investigate.</p>
Jerry, Keith	Competition Rules	<p>A number of suggestions for change were made:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Could it be split into four separate documents, each with a brief introductory statement, the rules, and possibly an afternote providing historical information. 2) Could there be a section on hints and tips for judges (suggestions to Jon please). 3) What exactly is a “single-line” kite if launching and/or control needs more than one person? 4) The Edwardian Kite section needs a time limit for relaunch. 5) Perhaps more examples in the single-line section are needed. 6) The weighting of scores is under consideration (by Jerry). 7) the date 2010 should be replaced by 2011 <p>The idea of the rules is that they will be put on the website for the benefit of competition organisers as a starting set of rules that could be adapted.</p> <p>Keith would accept suggestions and co-ordinate them and send the result in ‘track changes’ format back to Jerry</p>
